

Get your Kicks and Moola Too!!!

You'll get your Kicks on Route 66 and win Moola at Downstream Casino on this great overnight trip! We'll start our historic Route 66 excursion in Lebanon, where we'll visit historic Route 66 sites and the Lebanon-Laclede County Route 66 Museum. Following segments of Route 66 to Joplin, we'll see historic sites in Springfield and have a step on guide in Carthage. After crossing the Oklahoma border, we'll check into Downstream Casino Resort. Here you can dine when you want at Spring River Buffet and experience the fun and excitement of gaming for the evening. You will receive \$15 free Q play at the casino.

After spending the night at Downstream we continue our Route 66 travels in Kansas, driving the original Kansas portion of Route 66, found in the "Ozark Plateau" or Southeast corner of the state. We'll see many of the original structures of "The Mother Road," including the only remaining Marsh Arch Bridge on Route 66, and visit towns of Galena and Baxter Springs. We'll stop at the Galena Mining and Historical Museum to see what mining was like in the oldest mining town in Kansas. In Baxter Springs, the First Kansas Cow Town, you will enjoy Decades of Wheels, a car museum which opened in October 2018 and spans a city block. We'll have lunch and time for shopping before learning the history of Baxter Springs at their museum. We end our Route 66 tour in Quapaw, OK and see the marker "where east meets west" which denotes the location where the Route 66 crews from the east and west met to celebrate the completion of Route 66.
