#### **MONDAY, JULY 7**

This 5 to 5.5-hour excursion where a certified driver-naturalist provides in-depth information about the history of the park while we keep a keen lookout for wildlife and photo opportunities. Tonight, we'll check into our Denali-area hotel for one night.

#### **MONDAY, JULY 14**

Downtown **Skagway** features historic false-front shops and restaurants, wooden sidewalks, locals in period costumes and restored buildings, many of which are part of the National Park Service's Klondike Gold Rush National Historic Park. With a wide variety of shore excursions available, including a ride in an antique train car on the White Pass & Yukon Railway with views of spectacular scenery and a thrilling ride in a sled pulled by a team of Alaskan Huskies, there's something for everyone in Skagway!

#### **TUESDAY, JULY 15**

#### ARRIVE: 7:00 AM **DEPART: 3:00 PM**

**Icy Strait Point** is located on Chichagoff Island, home to more brown bears than humans, where eagles soar overhead and whales are regularly seen just offshore. Experience the true Alaskan wilderness as you are surrounded by rainforest and mist-shrouded mountains. Explore a restored 1912 salmon cannery and museum, nature trails, and even a beach. Icy Strait Point is the port for adventure. Glide down the world's largest ZipRider, whale watch in the waters of Port Frederick and Point Adolphus, search for the coastal brown bears, or soar high above it all in a helicopter.

#### **WEDNESDAY, JULY 16**

#### **ARRIVE: 10:00 AM DEPART: 5:30 PM**

**Ketchikan** is set at the southernmost entrance to Alaska's famed Inside Passage with a network of waterways that snake through some of the most spectacular wilderness in the world. It is best known for three things: Feisty salmon, idyllic scenery, and an incredibly rich Alaskan Native culture. From here you can visit Misty Fjords National Monument by seaplane or boat. This 2.3 million-acre park is stunning, with massive glacial cliffs and secluded bays. Other popular excursions include Totem Heritage Center with its collection of over 30 totems dating back to the 19th century, fishing expeditions, hiking, and kayaking.

#### THURSDAY, JULY 17

#### **SCENIC CRUISING**

Get ready for amazing views and wildlife like nowhere else as you sail through Alaska's **Inside Passage**. You'll have panoramic views of hanging glaciers, fjords and coastal mountains. Be on the watch for whales, sea lions, seals, and a variety of water foul.
